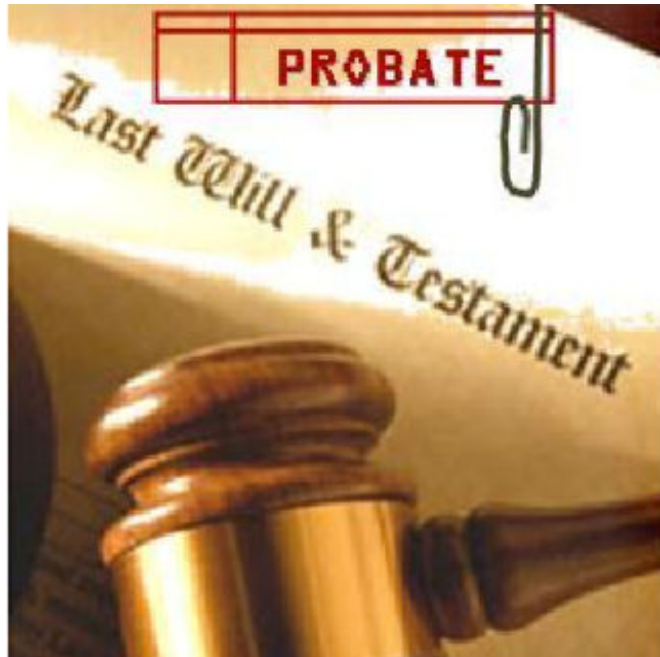
How to Avoid Probate

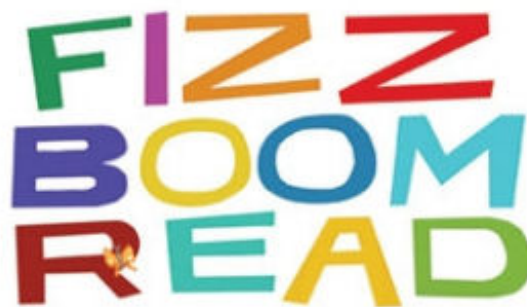

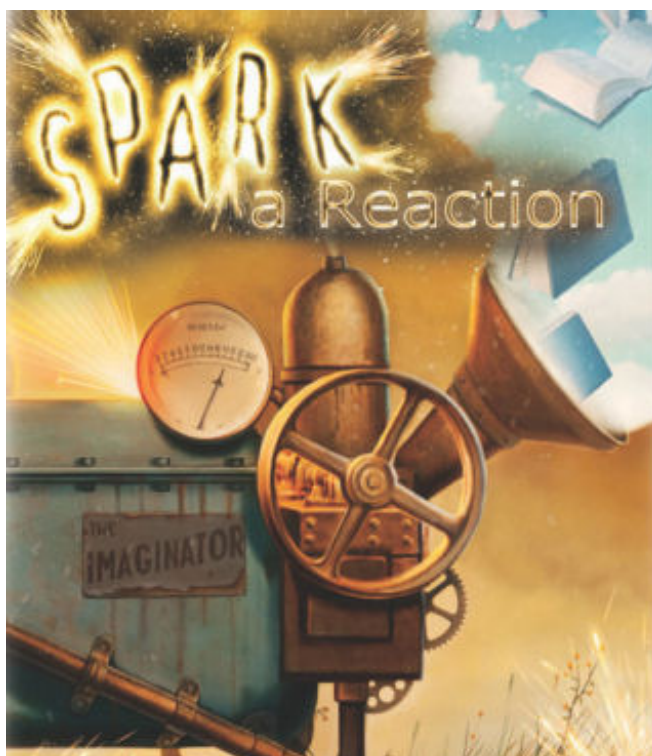
Teen Summer Reading Earn Badges, Win Prizes!
